IMPORTANT First Year Student/New Student Information:

For first year students, the band journey begins with a part placement. This process determines the part and instrument each musician will play in the band. Nothing needs to be prepared, but musicians must arrive at the band room with their instruments. Musicians will individually sight read a music excerpt and play scales. If musicians play specialty instruments (ex. tuba, baritone saxophone, tenor saxophone, etcetera), we will issue a school-owned instrument with no further fees at the part placement. Once the part placement is completed, musicians are dismissed. Musicians will perform on a first come, first served basis. Part placement dates are as follows. There are no appointments; please visit when it works best. Returning students do not need to attend a placement.
